I served on three public school councils and two Dandenong City Council committees. 2.I was an active ALP member from 5/2015-01/2019, before resigning to be a non-partisan person, free and independent politically. 3. I was a key founding member of CAMA-Chinese Australian Multicultural Association in Box Hill from late 2018 throughout 2019. Co-founder of Bilingual English Chinese Corner at Box Hill Gardens 02/2019-12/2019. 4. Volunteered coordinator for various Covid-19 groups, including CALAC- Chinese Australian League Against Covid-19, Anna Charity Foundation, AUS-CHN Covid-19 Fundraising etc.

4. What positive achievements resulted from your membership of these groups?

Successfully campaigned for traffic signage change for David St-a main street in central Dandenong, to streamline traffic flow especially in peak hours. Volunteered and donated for Labor movement. Contributed to bringing Chinese Australians closer within ourselves and with mainstream community, including the fact that the first 5 non-Chinese members signed up with CAMA largely because of my introduction and influence. The growth and popularity of the English corner was phenomenal. Significantly increased communication, coordination and cooperation in the frantic rush of many Chinese Australian groups and individuals in helping Victoria fighting the coronavirus in the earlier months, including helping channeling \$15k or so donation from Chinese individuals into Box Hill Hospital to buy ECMO.

5. Please state what you want to achieve as an elected Councillor

Please be referred to my candidate statement on minwenwu.com. I love real, concrete stuff instead of empty political slogans or paperwork/lip services, to really make the community better, as I know deep down in my heart that's the only thing that really works and lasts. I deem myself as an authentic Australian at heart, who was born in China but attracted by Australia in searching for a better life as so many Box Hill residents were, who has a huge capacity to contribute to this emerging 2nd city of Melbourne.

6. What are the top five issues you believe could improve the functioning of the *Whitehorse City Council* in representing its ratepayers and community?

- 1) Weekly listening posts with ward residents, which I will hold on every Sunday afternoon 2pm-5pm at parks if elected.
- 2) Walk the talk. Walk the streets and neighborhood often and talk to residents often, as I've been doing as much as possible in the past lockdown months, and will do more if elected and with the virus gone.
- Be humble, be down to earth, be fair dinkum, be open minded, be courageous, be a leader, be Australian.

- 4) A regular public stand-up forum in Box Hill Gardens/ Surrey Park /Box Hill Mall, like the speaker's corner in Hyde Park London, which I will set up if elected. It has embedded in my mind since 30+ years ago when I first came across it when learning English at University of Science & Technology of China, although I have never been to any other place on Earth yet other than Australia and China.
