As the dust settles after Activity Centre Planning Changes – What next?

Background – In recent months significant changes to the Whitehorse Planning Scheme have been gazetted - high density zoning in Blackburn, Nunawading and Mitcham activity centres and the Box Hill and Burwood Suburban Rail Loop activity centres.

The activity centre changes follow an avalanche of government amendments to other aspects of planning.

The Planning and Environment act is also being updated. The proposed changes will further restrict resident appeal rights, community consultation and reduce council powers. A positive aspect is the strengthening of compliance and enforcement provisions.

Come along to the seminar to hear how council will manage the changes and how they will impact residents. There will be time allocated for Q&A.
